

SAPF Nature and Wildlife Photography Workshop

This workshop is limited to 12 people. It is available to all photographers who love nature and wildlife. Whether you're a beginner or an advanced photographer, this workshop will offer ample opportunities to improve your photography skills.

INSTRUCTOR: Amanda Luker AAPS, former SAPF Committee member and member of Edwardstown Photography Club.

EQUIPMENT: Camera with a telephoto lens and/or standard lens. A macro lens is optional. An ND Filter and/or Polariser are optional.

VENUE: Cleland Conservation Park, 365 Mount Lofty Road, Crafers.

DATE: Sunday, 14 April 2024

TIME: 9.30 am - 4.30 pm

Meet at 9.30 am in the Park cafe for a pre-workshop discussion about basic techniques with a concluding overview of advanced techniques such as panning, slow shutter speeds and multiple exposures.

We will then go into the field to put our knowledge into practice. At 12:00 noon, there will be a lunch break in the cafe. At this time, the staff feed the Rainbow Lorikeets nearby, giving us an excellent opportunity for action shots.

We return to the field for the afternoon session, which concludes at 4.30 pm.

COST: \$80.00 per person, which includes the Park entrance fee. Coffee breaks and lunch are at the participant's own expense.
