

SAPF "LIGHTROOM INTRODUCTORY COURSE"

The course is designed for extreme beginners in Lightroom who must have their own laptop computer with a recent version of Lightroom installed. Bring your laptop and a notebook to record personal notes to each session.

- All of the Lr Modules and how they are used.
- Raw files and Adobe Camera Raw....how to import files into Lr.
- File naming and tracking your images in your Pc via the Library Module.
- Summary of the introduction session.

Students may bring a selection of Raw Digital Images on a Card/USB/ Camera ready to be downloaded into the Lr program. The tutor will also provide some RAW images to work with.

- Practice editing Students own images.

- Advanced editing of the imported images.
- Interacting with Adobe Photoshop (Ps)
- All the other Modules and how they work.
- Exporting images to file location, file naming, file settings, file size, watermarking.

Day 4 – Saturday 9.30am – 12.30pm

- Advanced editing project - bringing it all together
- Revision
